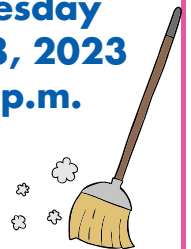

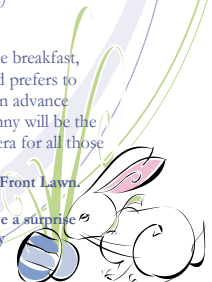

This period of the year is always exciting for golf maintenance crews and golfing enthusiast alike. Soon flowers, leaves, and buds will be appearing on our trees and shrubs, talk of The Masters tournament will begin, and everyone will start catching the "Golfing Bug". Most importantly, the grass will begin to transition into its growing season. Spring is a highly important time in getting the turf manicured and conditioned to standard and ready for summer performance. We have been working hard to get every part of the golf course in the best shape possible by working to remove dead trees from the grounds, raising and repairing irrigation heads, pole sawing, and cleaning various areas around the course. Our pre-emergent programs have been successful in keeping out weeds which really makes the golf course shine. We will be performing all the prep work necessary for the season by applying our spring/summer

preemergent, manicuring green surfaces, and tidying up various projects.

Though we have made huge strides on the golf course and I'm proud of how much we've accomplished, there is still plenty of work to be done. I ask that you help and support us in keeping Chatmoss a special place to cherish and revere by maintaining the planned course of improving different facets of the course. We still have more sand needed to replenish the bunkers, drainage that needs to be improved, and various other improvements/upgrades that are needed around the course. We ask that you please stay aware of cart traffic signs and cart rules as we have been experiencing unusually frequent rainfalls. So please adhere to them. I look forward to seeing everyone out playing and lets make 2023 a year to remember.

I will schedule a "Cabin Fever" event once I'm sure the courts will be ready, so stay tuned.

The lighting for indoor courts has been replaced and the court surface has been cleaned. In addition to preparing the clay courts, we are planning on painting the fitness facility, stripping and waxing the floors to the hallway and bathrooms, restocking some of the fitness equipment, and organizing the massage room. Unfortunately, quite a few exercise items have grown legs and escaped, so we will be changing the code to the fitness entry door and adding a camera to the entrance.

I would like to start a little booster for pickleball. We can create two sets of low profile lines on indoor court #3 with quality nets with wheels and some starter paddles and balls for around \$2500. Let me know how you'd like to support this endeavor.
