What a great summer at Chatmoss CC! The pool was in full swing along with a number of weddings and functions. Judy, Joe and P.C. have done a great job managing all the events and have met or exceeded budget every month! The last two years we have seen a nice increase in business even with the golf course closed for a period of time both years. The service they provide is only going to get better as the next Cap Ex budget project is upgrading the kitchen. The project entails new lights, major electrical, new steamer tables, heat lamps, new freezer, range and numerous banquet items so we can handle the large functions without rentals.

Thanks to all who have supported the Cap Ex project! Now we are able to make the much-needed repairs and improvements that have been deferred for a number of years due to the lack of cash flow. A number of projects have been completed; the Pavilion deck and bathrooms along with the outside bathrooms under the casual dining room have been upgraded. New playground equipment and swings were added. We have purchased a new ball picker upper and mats for the range. We completed tree work, re-contouring on #'s 7, 8, and 14. Repaired the bridge on four and put down 4 truckloads of zoysia in key traffic areas around the course. The course looks phenomenal!

The next project after the kitchen is the upgrading the interior of the clubhouse along with the exterior and the tennis facility. We hope to get these underway soon when we receive more commitments for the Cap Ex fund. We have a tremendous amount of momentum at the club, and the plan is to continue this throughout this year and into next with the Cap Ex projects. I hope more of you can participate to help make Chatmoss CC be the best it can be!

I also look forward to celebrating our 60th anniversary on Saturday, November 10th. Hope to see you at the club.


